## CYFARFOD CYMUNED COMMUNITY MEETING 6<sup>th</sup> August 2012

Below is a brief report of the topics covered during the Community Meeting.

### DEVELOPMENT & LOTTERY

There has now been a response from Ceredigion County Council with regards to a suggested 'fair rent' to be charged on the building. They have requested us to pay £200 per month, from 02/03/2012 to 01/09/2012, and £300 per month from 02/09/2012 to 01/03/2013. This would be in the form of a 12 months lease to allow time for Cymuned to raise the funds to purchase the old school. If this proves not to be sufficient time then the lease will be referred back to the Cabinet at Ceredigion County Council.

Further planning meetings, for the preparation of documents for the Big Lottery bid, have been arranged, the next one being 8.00pm Monday 13th August.

An update is to be sought on the progress with regards to the work being carried out by Quantity Surveyor, Construction Design Manager and Architect.

### CLUBS, GROUPS & SOCIALS

Live Entertainment - Saturday 15th September has been provisionally arranged for the next live show. Ian Roberts will be confirming the date with local entertainer Phil Fernando. Also, Ian Roberts is attempting to arrange for Mal Pope to perform either on Saturday 6th or 20th October.

A date has been arranged, on 29th September, for the First Aid Awareness Training with Michael Morgan. Course will be for 3 hours, commencing at 10.00am. There are 13 names on the list to date. Details were published on web site and in August's edition of the newsletter.

The Art Group will be having an exhibition of their work, during October. The date will be either Saturday 6th or 20th October, dependent on the date booked for the live entertainment. The exhibition will also be open for viewing on the following Sunday.

A quote is to be obtained for advertising sign(s) that will be used to raise awareness of events that are taking place at the Centre.

### SERVICES

Sandra Shell has volunteered her services, and considerable expertise, to look after First Aid related issues at the Community Centre. This will mainly entail looking after and monitoring all First Aid equipment and ensuring we are compliant with the equipment we hold.

**BROADBAND** - the issue of the poor broadband service has again been highlighted by residents in the village and surrounding area. A meeting will be arranged, if possible with a representative of BT present, to look at the options of improving the service and any schemes that we could utilise to find funding.

The Welsh Assembly still provide up to £1,000 to fund a download speed of 2Mb. You do not have to pay any money out personally. Further information will be provided in the next newsletter.

To further the Community Generation Project we would have to go to planning. Confirmation is to be sought with regards to the cost of the project, projected generation figures, electricity generation tariffs and recommended separation distances.

A Welsh musician and composer, who is especially notable for his contribution to music theatre portraying Welsh national identities and themes. He resides at the village of Mumbles, Swansea.

In the early 1970s, a tape of Pope's songs was sent by his brother to BBC Radio 1 presenter John Peel, who invited Pope to perform at the BBC. The session resulted in a recording contract with Elton John's recording company Rocket Records.

In 1982, Pope returned to Wales, working for BBC Radio Wales in Cardiff. Combining the activities of singer, songwriter and broadcaster, wrote songs for Cliff Richard and The Hollies, duetted with Bonnie Tyler and Aled Jones, and toured with Art Garfunkel and Belinda Carlisle.
