Ceredigion Cost of Living Bulletin: Learning without Limits

Free School Meals

All full-time primary school pupils in Ceredigion are automatically entitled to free school meals.

Secondary school pupils, including 6th form pupils, get free meals if their parent or carer meets certain criteria.

School Essentials Grant

The School Essentials Grant offers up to £200 for things like uniform, sports kit, IT equipment and extra kit for school trips.

Primary school pupils eligible for free school meals used to get the School Essentials Grant automatically.

Now that Welsh Government has introduced universal free school meals, you need to apply for the School Essentials Grant. The application process is the same as the Free School Meals application.

My Travel Pass - £1 bus fare scheme

Young people aged 16 – 21 year olds can apply for a My Travel Pass with Transport for Wales.

A new Welsh Government scheme offers single fares for just £1 and day tickets for £3 with participating bus companies. The scheme offers unlimited affordable bus travel for young people to help them access education, training, employment, and leisure.

From 3rd November, the scheme will be extended to offer the same reduced fares to people aged 5-15 years too.

This is a pilot scheme which will run until August 2026.

Pre-loved school Uniforms and logos

Some Ceredigion schools offer a pre-loved uniform swap. This is good for the environment as well as your pocket. Swap shops can also work for World Book Day, costumes, football boots etc

Ask at your child's school if they have one. If they don't, perhaps you could help to set one up?

Some schools are also looking at other ways of reducing the cost of the school uniform. Children in Wales have some good examples on their website: Children in Wales | Supporting Change: School Uniform

Education Maintenance Allowance (EMA)

If you're 16-18 you can apply for £40 per week to help with the costs of further education. You must be at school or college for at least 12 hours per week and studying an eligible course. Your annual household income must be £25,974 or less.

Welsh Government Learning Grant

Welsh Government Learning Grant FE is an income-assessed grant that aims to encourage more people to continue with their education.

It can help with the costs of your education if you're aged 19+. Full time students could receive up to £1,919 per year, part time students could get up to £959 a year.

Coleg Ceredigion – Financial Contingency Fund

Learners at Coleg Ceredigion can apply to the college Financial Contingency Fund to help remove financial barriers to learning.

This can help with the cost of childcare, transport, lunch allowance, course equipment costs such as uniform, paying for DBS checks and, on occasion emergency payments to those in dire financial need.

Ceredigion Carer Cards

If you're a young carer or an adult carer in Ceredigion, you can apply for a Carer ID card. This gives you access to discounts and services in Ceredigion, including driving theory support, Dysgu Bro courses, workshops at Denmark Farm Conservation Centre and lots more.
