Alexander Holloway from the Aeron Valley Wellbeing Hub recently completed professional training with the charity 'Playlist For Life' which will help to bring the power of personal music to people living with dementia at the new Playlist For Life Help Point at Pennant Community Centre, Ceredigion.

Alexander recently undertook training in the Dance Your Ability method of therapeutic, inclusive groupled movement & self-led dance programs to people of all abilities & all ages, including: at-risk youth, mixed abilities, people living with: dementia, Parkinson's, cancer, addictions, in recovery, incarcerated and trauma survivors.

Alex now leads regular seated dance sessions for elders on Mondays 11am at Pennant Community Centre and at many local care homes in Ceredigion. It was at this time that he began to see the wellbeing benefits of music relating to an individual's life.

"I observe so much joy and laughter when a familiar song comes on, attendees begin singing along, sharing memories linked to the songs and this improves their wellbeing, especially for sufferers of dementia."

Alexander Holloway has joined music and dementia charity Playlist for Life's national Help Point network, to share the power of personal music for people affected by dementia in local communities.

More than two decades of research shows that 'personal music' – the specific tunes attached to someone's emotions that spark memories – can help those living with dementia by alleviating stress, managing symptoms and strengthening relationships with family members and carers.

Alexander recently received a grant to purchase Mp3 players and headphones that can be borrowed for free by carers of dementia sufferers so they can create a personalised playlist of music for those they care for. Alexander is also able to provide free 'get started' resources and information about creating and using a personalised playlist of music. Alexander will be hosting a month of events at Pennant Community Centre throughout June including presentations on Playlist For Life, how to get started finding music related to a person's life, a workshop on how to use mp3 players and download music and ongoing support.-
