UKRAINE AID

Listed below are some of the things that have been requested to take as aid to Ukraine.

- There is a desperate shortage of children's shoes and footwear in general;
- Children's & Adult clothing for hot weather hotter in Ukraine than in UK at present;
- If you have any prescription medicines or, other medical supplies, that are not required. This includes first aid kits or first aid supplies. It does not matter if items have expired dates as they can still save lives;
- Chainsaws, strimmers/brush cutters and generators;
- Hand tools
- Shoe boxes or boxes containing personal hygiene items such as toothbrushes, toothpaste, soap, deodorants, shower gel, baby wipes, washing powder, etc; and
- Knitted trauma teddies that are used to raise funds.

If you have any other items not listed, that you think might be of use, please contact Malcolm Sumner to ascertain if they are required.
